

Follow These Instructions Once You Have Scheduled Your Vaccine



Congratulations on taking this important step for your health and our community! Please read the following instructions prior to your first vaccination date.

Understanding the Vaccine

- Prior to receiving the vaccine, please review the Vaccine Fact Sheet. If you have any medical questions, please contact your medical provider.
- As we discussed when you scheduled your appointment, you must receive two doses of the vaccine on two different dates. It is critical that you attend both vaccination dates you were given.

By Invitation Only

- Only patients who received an invitation and called to schedule their vaccine appointment will be vaccinated.
- The COVID-19 vaccine is in limited supply; it is being administered based on Priority Groups defined by the North Dakota Department of Health.
- Vaccines and vaccine invitations cannot be shared. If you are unable to take the dose that you are eligible to receive, the dose will be given to another eligible patient according to the Priority Groups from the Department of Health.

If You Have COVID-19 Symptoms

- If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms prior to your scheduled vaccination, please call us immediately. Anyone with symptoms should stay home and will not be permitted to attend their vaccination appointment. When you no longer have symptoms, check with your provider for guidance on when you can receive the vaccine.
- Because this vaccine is in limited supply, it is very important that we have as much advance notice as possible if you will not be attending your appointment.

On the Day of Your Vaccine

- Your vaccine appointments will be held at Trinity Health, Health Center – West, 101 3rd Ave SW in Minot.
- To ensure safe social distancing, please do not enter the facility until your scheduled appointment time.
- Please be prepared to show your Photo ID when presenting for your vaccination.
- Only companions who are needed for patient mobility will be allowed into the building. We ask that all other companions wait in the vehicle. This will help us maintain safe distancing for our vaccination patients.
- Masks are required for anyone in a Trinity Health facility throughout their visit.
- We recommend that you remain at Trinity Health for 15 minutes after receiving your vaccination to be sure you have access to medical care, in the rare instance that you experience an allergic reaction. If you have a companion who drove you to the clinic, you may wait in your vehicle with that companion. However, if you have previously experienced a severe allergic reaction to any immunization, we highly recommend that you wait INSIDE our facility for 30 minutes.
