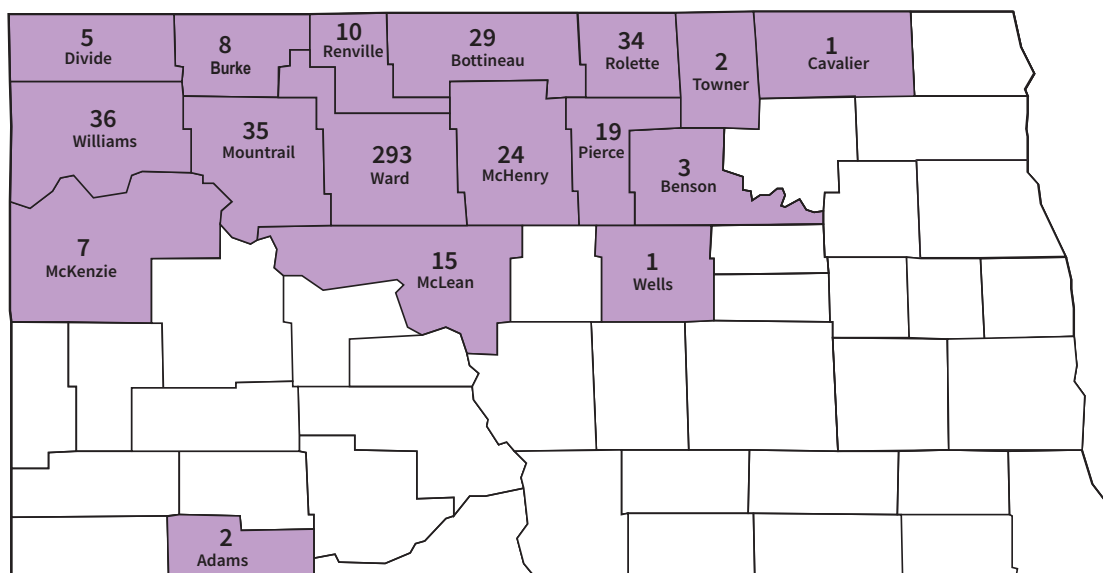

Trinity Health Statistics - 2020

There are 14,121 cancer primaries in the Trinity Health cancer registry from 1990 (assessment year) through 2020. This number represents cancer primaries diagnosed and/or treated at Trinity Health.

The following map shows the geographic distribution.

In 2020, the number of those cases was 530.

According to *Cancer Facts & Figures 2020* from the American Cancer Society, about 80% of all cancers, in the United States, are diagnosed in persons 55 and older.

In 2020, approximately 88% of all cancers diagnosed at Trinity Health were in persons 50 and older.



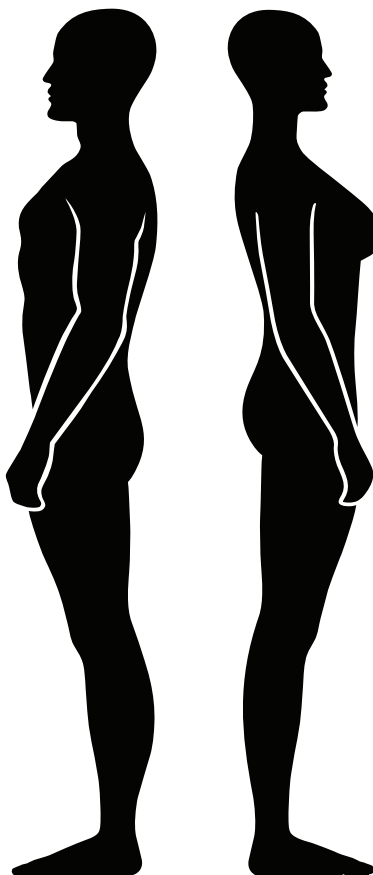
