Requirements

All new graduate RNs hired to one of the participating units at Trinity Hospital will be automatically enrolled in the Nurse Residency Program. There is no separate application process. Nurse Residents must:

- Be hired to a participating unit at Trinity Health
- Be committed to the yearlong residency program
- Hold an active nursing license
- Have worked less than 6 months as an RN
