# Safe Kids Minot and Injury Prevention





Safe Kids Minot was no exception when it came to the unexpected challenges presented by COVID-19. This global pandemic brought many event changes and cancellations, as well as a 2.5-month-long furlough of the halftime Safe Kids Coordinator.

Community car seat checks have been on hold and have required some creativity to find alternative options for scheduling—by appointment, virtually, and at outdoor spaces and in large indoor spaces that accommodate social distancing.

Wild About Safety, our community safety day, has been postponed until 2022. The event partners agreed to postpone the event for a time that would be safer for the community to gather and learn about injury prevention and keeping kids safe. Event partners include Minot Fire Department, Roosevelt Park Zoo, Trinity Health, First District Health Unit, Trinity Health Foundation, and Minot Police Department. Event sponsors include Enbridge, AAA, Town & Country Credit Union, BNSF, First Western Bank, Minot Local Fire 1157, North American Coal, and Dacotah Bank.

Safe Kids Minot community education has adapted by transitioning to a virtual platform for most events. In-person teaching is done where allowed and when social distancing can be achieved. Elementary students headed outdoors for some fresh air and education during the summer months. Safe Kids Minot added pandemic relevant information to their traditional preventable injury curriculum, including how to stay safe at home during Covid-19, proper hand washing, social distancing, and mask wearing. STOP THE BLEED® classes were taught in a socially distanced environment with masks and individual supplies were provided for each participant. Safe Kids Minot will continue to adapt to this everchanging time with creativity.

Safe Kids Minot Events 2020

Despite the pandemic Safe Kids Minot was able to safely engage in educational events with a total of more than 1200 caregivers and children served. (Cancelled events due to COVID-19 have a ~~strikethrough~~.)
