Trinity Health's Story

The earliest pages of Trinity's story were written in the churches that dotted northwest North Dakota during the early 20th Century. Spurred by the twin calamities of World War I and an influenza pandemic, church leaders envisioned a hospital to serve the healthcare needs of a broad region. These Lutherans gathered in Minot on April 25, 1922. Their purpose was to form an association that would raise funds for a 30-bed hospital in Minot, the first phase of a four-phase construction plan. Trinity Health was founded.

The key figure in Trinity's founding – Rev. T.F. Gullixson – encouraged a philosophy of “no minimums.” Hence, Trinity Health defined a broad mission for itself, becoming both a place of healing and a teaching center committed to training the next generation of healthcare providers. This combination inspired an approach to healthcare services that was unusually advanced for a hospital far removed from a large university center. For example, in 1964 Trinity became the first hospital between Minneapolis and Spokane to provide open heart surgery. In 1968 it briefly launched the nation's first helicopter ambulance.

Along with innovation came expansion. In 1971, Trinity Hospital united with the Lutheran Homes, giving patients and families an enhanced continuum of care. In 2001 Trinity Health consolidated Minot's healthcare facilities with the purchase of the former St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Arts Clinic.

Today, Trinity Health is the region's premier health system and a proud member of the Mayo Clinic Care Network. With a tertiary care hospital in Minot, rural health facilities and a long-term care center, Trinity provides a full complement of healthcare services to communities in North Dakota and Eastern Montana.

Over the past 100 years Trinity Health has achieved countless milestones and innovations. With our new campus, we will offer even more clinical advancements and the latest technology that will solidify our place as a regional referral and healthcare system for many years to come. What will never change is our commitment to always look ahead and improve ourselves in ways that will provide the most exceptional care possible for our patients, their families, and the communities we serve.
